LIVING & DINING CONFIRMATION FEE

Description	Amount
<p>A one-time confirmation fee is assessed to the student's ASU Student Account upon signing and submitting of the University Housing License Agreement Contract and is non-refundable. Fee is nonrefundable and is applied each semester to all housing applicants who are not currently living on campus.</p> <p>This fee may be waived only if you have lived on campus for the entire preceding academic semester. If at any point in time during your enrollment at ASU, you resided off campus or do not attend classes during any previous academic semester, you are required to submit a new application to reside on campus and are thus responsible for this fee.</p> <p>If you are applying to for housing for the Fall 2019 semester, you must have lived on campus for the entire Spring 2019 semester to be considered for a waiver of this fee. If you are applying to for housing for the Spring 2020 semester, you must have lived on campus for the entire Fall 2019 semester to be considered for a waiver of this fee.</p> <p>If you are applying for summer housing, you must be living on campus for the entire spring semester in order to be considered for a waiver of this fee.</p>	\$125

PAYMENT

View Student Account: To view your student account, log onto My ASU and select the Finances tab.

Late Charge Assessment: Charges must be paid by the date due. University billings not paid by the date due are subject to late charges beginning at 30 days past due and continuing monthly until paid in full.

ASU Payment Plan: Students with an outstanding balance of \$500 or more of unpaid eligible ASU charges by the designated payment deadline will be automatically enrolled in the ASU Payment Plan. Students automatically enrolled will be responsible for the ASU Payment Plan fee billed to their student account. ASU does not withdraw students from classes during the current semester for nonpayment and students must withdraw before the semester or session starts if they decide to not attend. Delinquent Accounts: Delinquent accounts will be referred to outside collection agencies and will be reported to national credit bureaus. Should it become necessary for ASU to retain an attorney or collection agency to secure payment of any amount due, the debtor is responsible for paying all attorney's fees court costs, and collection agency charges. Late fees may continue to accrue monthly or be assessed as a flat fee when accounts are transferred between agencies until the balance is paid in full.
