What Not to Bring

Hoverboards and motorized scooters Bed lofting kits Personal wireless access points or Cigarettes, e-cigarettes, cigars, routers and wireless printers pipes, hookahs and other smoking or vaping equipment are prohibited Flammable items in our residential facilities and on (candles, gasoline, etc.) Flushable toilet wipes campus. Non UL (Underwriters Laboratories) Open heating elements (toasters, hot plates, electric approved items heaters, etc.) **Fireworks** Gaming devices that use the Pets Halogen lamps "wireless" network Voice activated assistant Weapons Drugs, alcohol and all associated Window decorations (external paraphernalia facing decor is prohibited)

All items should be labeled with your first and last name, residence hall and room number.

Consolidate all items to be unloaded into one vehicle to reduce the amount of cars in the unloading zones.
