Guests under the age of 18 must be registered by their host (ASU resident for that specific community) when entering a residential community. Guest(s) must present a valid form of identification. Any minor (under the age of 18) not presenting a valid ASU ID must have approval in writing by a parent or legal guardian, including a valid emergency contact number in the event of a crisis. The host must escort guests at all times. "Minor Consent to Stay" forms must be turned in during business hours at least 24 hours before guest arrives.
